

Scholarship Request Form

Camp Randall Rowing Club is dedicated to supporting Junior, and Middle School rowers and WeCanRow participants who otherwise would not have an opportunity to participate in the sport of rowing, to developing athletic activities for youth and adults of all social and economic backgrounds and promoting lifelong healthy activities through an understanding and appreciation of the sport of rowing.

Eligibility: All current or future members of Camp Randall Rowing Club (CRRC) are eligible for partial or full fee awards for participation in CRRC-sponsored activities. Previous rowing experience is not required.

The CRRC Junior Scholarship Fund & WeCanRow Scholarship Fund: These are limited scholarship funds created to defray the costs of CRRC membership and program participation. To assure equitable allocation of these limited funds, applicants are asked to complete the following form. All applicants are required to pay the first \$100 of the respective CRRC season's fees. Scholarships are limited to 75% of the total season's fee. The application is confidential, and will be reviewed only by the Finance Committee. The Finance Committee makes awards based upon financial need, positive attitude, commitment, attendance, length of participation and active volunteer participation. Without disclosing financial information, the committee seeks specific recommendations from the coaches about commitment, attendance and length of participation. To stretch scholarship funds as far as possible, the Committee gives preference to applications for partial awards and requests for payment terms. Failure to participate in rowing activities for which the scholarship applies will result in ineligibility for future scholarship awards. Scholarships will be awarded only to the extent that funds are available.
