

## WeCanRow-Madison Scholarship Form

Camp Randall Rowing Club (CRRC) is dedicated to financially assisting women cancer survivors who otherwise would not have an opportunity to participate in the sport of rowing. Funding options to assist rowers include: awarding scholarship monies or payment plans **based upon financial need**, and multiple rower discounts. Scholarships are offered once year, coinciding with the start of the annual season in Spring.

**CRRC WeCanRow Scholarship Fund:** These are limited scholarship funds created to defray the costs of program participation. No CRRC fee income is used for the Scholarship Fund. CRRC WCR conducts fundraising activities to raise money for Scholarship Fund, in addition to seeking grants from community foundations and individual donations. Scholarships will be awarded only to the extent that funds are available.

**Eligibility:** All members of the CRRC WeCanRow (WCR) program are eligible to apply for scholarship awards. Previous rowing experience is not required.

**Need-Based Scholarship.** Scholarships are limited to no more than 50% of the total season's fees. The CRRC Finance Committee makes awards based primarily upon financial need. In addition, without disclosing the applicant's financial information, the Committee also seeks specific recommendations from the coaching staff.

**Need Based Payment Plan.** Payment plans are approved on a financial need basis. Payments will be spread over a 5 month period March to July.

**Multiple Family Member Scholarship.** Scholarships up to 50% of the fee are available to women who have family members registered for the current year CRRC Junior spring rowing season. **Confidentiality:** The application materials and review process are strictly confidential, conducted solely by the CRRC Finance Committee. All Social Security numbers are redacted from submitted documentation prior to review by the Committee. All Committee members are committed to maintaining the strict confidentiality of the application and decision-making process.

A **\$100.00 deposit must be submitted along with the scholarship/payment plan application by the DUE DATE.** Application deadline will be published in the OARacle or inquiry at [wecanrowmadison@gmail.com](mailto:wecanrowmadison@gmail.com). Applications will not be considered for participants:

1. with outstanding unpaid balances from prior seasons.
2. who did not comply with the conditions of prior scholarship awards.
3. who do not submit all of the required information prior to the application deadline.
